



CODE OF CONDUCT

Amplify provides an excellent opportunity for fellowship and interaction both among and between youth groups. Group leaders can also use it as a time to teach students the importance of living their witness for Christ at all times and letting their light shine to unbelievers at the conference and in the public arena. In order for this to happen the following guidelines for conduct must be observed.

1. All youth groups will be under the direct supervision of their group leader for the duration of the weekend. Each group leader must assume responsibility for enforcing this code of conduct.
2. Fireworks, alcohol, tobacco products and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited.
3. Backpacks will not be permitted in the convention center.
4. Each group will be responsible for any damage done to their rooms after check-in. Payment for damages must be settled with the hotel before your departure.
5. All groups should be in their rooms by 1:00 AM Friday and Saturday nights. Please remember there are other guests in the hotel besides Amplify groups; we must show consideration for other guests. Even if other guests are rowdy and disrespectful, we will not copy that behavior. Please refrain from excessive noises, loud talking in hallways/rooms and playing on elevators.
6. Visiting in the hotel room of a member of the opposite sex is not permissible.
7. No prank phone calls or fire alarms. Both of these actions are criminal offenses and may result in arrest.
8. Please show respect to those in authority. Make it your mission to behave in such a way that is pleasing to and brings glory to God.
9. If proper conduct is not maintained, the hotel staff will give those who are out of order a verbal warning. On the second offense, the group leader and Amplify staff will be contacted. Should a third offense occur, the group will be asked to leave the premises. Please be mindful of your actions.
10. All students, leaders and parents with your group MUST wear the Amplify Wristband provided in your packet. No one is permitted to any Amplify session without it.
11. Have a GREAT time! Enjoy one another and enjoy spending time with the Lord together. Smile often. Laugh together. Be silly and act goofy, but, "...whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31. All of these things can be done lovingly, respectfully and with a good attitude. We are looking forward to an AMPLIFIED weekend with you!

While staying at the hotel:

- Hotel employees and property are to be respected at all times. Rules/schedules for use of hotel swimming pool, sauna, exercise room, Jacuzzi, and any other public areas must be followed.

Amplify 2018 Code of Conduct is to be observed while on hotel and other properties:

- Each chaperone (not just the group leader!) should remind everyone in his/her group that they represent the church and more importantly Jesus.
- Each chaperone must know the whereabouts of his/her group at all times.
- Each chaperone is responsible for the behavior of his/her group at all times.
